* Check in time will be Tuesday August 31st @ noon and check out will be Monday September 6th at noon.

* Upon arrival please see Sharon Hewitt (BBB President) with your camping fees \$35.00 per rig (up to 5 people) and your negative coggins. You will be asked to read and sign our Club rules/Hold Harmless and all of the Forestry rules including the Bear rules.

* All campers will need to have their site inspected by an officer prior to vacating their site. Any person's site left in non compliance of the forestry rules with manure clean up procedures will be asked to pay the Club a \$35.00 manure clean up fee. Thanks!
