New changes for upcoming Doe Lake campouts:

Jean made a motion for the \$40 for non members who would like to camp to be dropped, and for them to be charged \$20, in hopes of getting more members. (Rules still apply if a person attends 2 events, they have to join on the 3rd event.) One guest group per member is able to attend Doe Lake. This motion passed. For those of you who tethered your horse they are back. Motion passed to reinstate ground tethers, **Once your tether is in the ground you MAY NOT move it. If we have problems with crowding, the president or vice president may have to ask you to use tie outs. This way we can make room for others. Ground ties MAY NOT cross roads or block entrances to trails, if this happens you will be asked to move your horses. Please be courteous to those around you, this way every one can enjoy their stay.** Tether is limited to 16ft. No longer.

Lisa made a motion to eliminate the manure fee, this passed with this change: **Every member must clean their site, for those who leave with their site a mess, you will be mailed a certified letter stating you have 30 days to pay a \$35 clean up fee. If this is not paid your membership will be terminated for the remainder of that year.**

Marylou asked if there is any member who would like to host a ride. Due to gas cost not everyone is always able to travel to the same location. This way those that may want to travel has the opportunity to ride somewhere new, and meet new members.
